BULGARIA - ROMANIA MINISTRY REPORT

Four airline flights and 30 hours after leaving home, Tony and Marge Abram and I arrived into Varna, Bulgaria. It was late so we made a quick dash to the local McDonald's for a bite to eat, then drove to Obroi-chesta Ministry Center Complex where we would be staying during our time of ministry in Bulgaria. This center is absolutely beautiful! But it didn't come about without much pain, suffering, persecution, years of hard work and personal sacrifice on the part of Time and Betty Cornett. Two miles away is the Black Sea and many resorts where over 5 million people will visit this year. This Center is strategically located to minister to this vast harvest area next to Turkey.

Sister Cornett organizes and directs ministry to children, youth, men and women's seminars every week from early May through September. Hundreds of children and young people, many who come from Muslim families, receive the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Savior each year in these various camps and services.

Our first service began on Sunday at the Dobrich Home Church with a wonderful evangelistic, healing rally. Souls were saved and people received healing

beginning with the first service. The expectation of the people was high and they were hungry to hear from God.

Despite the soaring temperature to 100 plus degrees, the people faithfully attended four services each day to hear the teaching on The Anointing Makes the Difference. Their hunger for God and His Word was evident by the fact they were very sad when the last service came. They wanted to see the meetings continue. Oh that we would see this kind of hunger for God's Word again in America!

We knew they were receiving and believing the Word of God because they began to immediately put it into practice. One sister testified after hearing my message on Persistent Faith went home and spent time praying about a kidney stone that was giving her serious pain. She said she passed the stone in the night without medication or a Doctor.

Two young men after hearing Brother Tony teach on Believers Hands –that believers, according to Mark 16: 17,18, not just Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors or Teachers could lay hands on the sick and they would recover went during the afternoon break

to a man who was bedfast with paralysis. They read Mark 16: 17, 18 to him and when they laid their hands on him he said he felt an electric shock go down his spine. The warm healing presence and power of Jesus was upon him. For the first time in years he had feeling. There were two backslidden Christians there also and

We heard many wonderful testimonies of answered prayers.

We traveled each day from Obroichesta to Dobrich, about 25 miles apart. It would be late each night getting back and the rooms had no air conditioning. We would try opening the windows for some cooler air late in the night, but then you could not sleep for the barking dogs. We didn't get much quality rest but we were truly blessed.

The Men's Two Day Seminar began on Friday morning and continued until Saturday evening. Brother Tim Cornett directed the seminar and did a wonderful
