## HOW WILL YOU CHOOSE?

In the Gospel according to Luke, chapter ten verses twenty-five through thirty-seven, Jesus relates that magnificent story about the Good Samaritan in response to the question a certain self-righteous lawyer posed, testing Him: "And who is my neighbor?" "Then Jesus answered and said: 'A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead'.

Jesus then proceeds to tell how three different individuals came by and saw the man in this terrible condition and their reaction to him in his need. One was a priest, another a Levite, and the third, a certain Samaritan. The priest and Levite, after looking at the man, PASSED BY ON THE

OTHER SIDE—they refused to assist him, after all they had to rush to Jerusalem for some very important religious and spiritual matters to attend to. It was the despised Samaritan who assisted the man in his need.

It is quite obvious three philosophies or ways of thinking emerge here. One, the robbers BEAT HIM UP! Two, the priest and Levite PASSED HIM UP! Three, the Samaritan man PICKED HIM UP!

Jesus is clear in telling us we too, like the lawyer, must make a choice which group we will identify with and which philosophy we will adopt to follow. Personally, I choose to PICK THEM UP, and I trust that is also your choice. If so, it involves three important issues:

- 1. It requires IDENTIFICATION-** verses 33,34, *"And when he saw him, he had compassion on him, and went to him..."*
- 2. It requires INVOLVEMENT-** verse 34, *"and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him."*
- 3. It requires INVESTMENT-** verse 35, *"On the next day, when he departed, he took out two denarii, gave them to the inn keeper, and said to him, 'Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I come again, I will repay you.'"*
- 4. The result will be an INHERITANCE-** verse 42, *"But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."*

Jesus said when we choose to identify, become involved, and make investment in the ministry for lost souls wherever they are, we will share in the rewards of that harvest (see John 4:35-38).

## SHARING IN THE AFRICAN HARVEST

I recently returned from South Africa where Evangelist Tony Abram and I conducted a number of evangelistic services, church services, seminars and the annual Easter convention for Dr. and Mrs. T.J. Bronkhorst and Pastor Joey Chetty.

With the exception of a couple morning services, we witnessed many souls coming to Christ for salvation and healing in every meeting. It was glorious to witness the manifestation gifts of the Holy Spirit working prolifically in every service.

We began ministry among a number of churches in and around Durban, before going to Johannesburg for the Annual Easter Convention in Midrand. The first several days we had meetings at Faith Center in Demat. Pastor Stanley and Sandra Moodley are the pastors, and were also our lovely and gracious hosts. Surrounding their church is a vast harvest field! During the past year the government has built some 6000 small homes for the homeless. There are nearly 26,000 people living in this area, most of which do not have jobs, and need to be reached with the Gospel. Pastor Moodley has several young black pastors trained and working in this area. He plans to build a number of churches throughout this vast area to serve the people. Faith Center is reaching out to them with food, clothing, toys, the gospel and the love of God.

### THE HIGHLIGHT OF THE MISSION A MARVELOUS MIRACLE!!

In several issues of our newsletters I have reported on the ministry of Dr. and Mrs. T.J. Bronkhorst. Brother Bronkhorst served in the Armed Services in WWII while in his early twenties. Lying in a foxhole on his back watching bombs dropping all around him, one hit very close killing a fellow soldier and the blast damaged his hearing, resulting in excruciating painful headaches. There was nothing medical doctors could do for him. Their little daughter asked if she could pray for him. She laid her little hands on his head and said, "Dear Jesus, please heal my daddy of headaches", and instantly the pain stopped! He got so excited, he jump up on the bed, got on the floor doing somer-

saults, when his wife came into the room and thought he had gone insane! "I am healed", he cried!

He was 24 years of age when this miracle happened. He never had another headache for the

following 64 years, until four months ago when he was mugged on the street in a nearby town center from Orkney. For the past four months he suffered with severe headaches from the blow on the back of his head, and lost most of his voice. He was unable to drive his car, stand up well or walk straight. He has been confined to his home all this time unable to function well. The doctors had done just about everything they knew to do for him and the situation looked very bleak.

Tony and I requested Pastor Joey to take us to see him. It was nearly a three-hour drive to Orkney. It was obvious he was also suffering from depression as Satan pressed him sorely with lies: "You are finished. You are almost 89 years of age, why don't you quit, you will never be better?" He was facing the battle of his life. He knew he was not finished. He knew the Lord had more for him to do. Then, he told us that on the previous Sunday morning he and Sister Bronkhorst were sitting on the edge of their bed, unable to go to church, as they talked with the Lord. They experienced a glorious manifestation of the Lord's presence and felt the assurance things were going to change.

As we sat at the table for lunch, suddenly an awesome anointing of the Holy Spirit came upon me and as I began prophesying to him, the presence of the Lord saturated the room. The Lord gave him words of encouragement and instructions. His time was not up and God had much for him yet to do. IMMEDIATELY he changed! The color and expressions of his face showed he had been miraculously touched. "Maria", he said, "I feel great!" "The Lord has touched me!" He tested himself, and noted that he was no longer dizzy, was able to stand, walk, bend, etc. without any pain or problems. Furthermore, his strong voice came back. Totally restored!

The next morning was Easter Sunday and to the surprise of the congregation, he and Marie got up early, and he drove the nearly 3 hours from Orkney to Midrand. He looked and felt terrific and his booming voice rang out as he testified and shouted 'Hallelujah, I am healed!'
